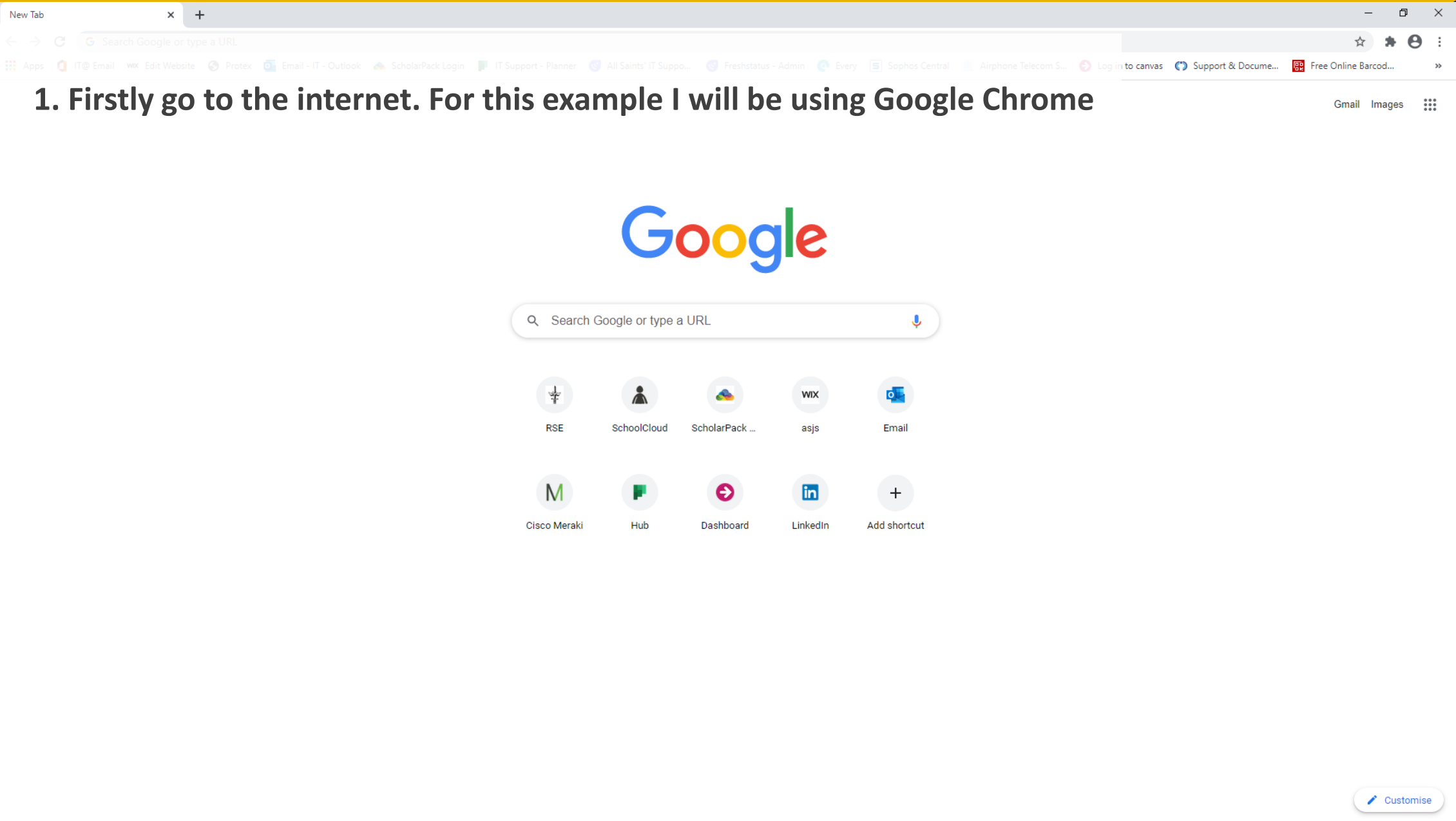

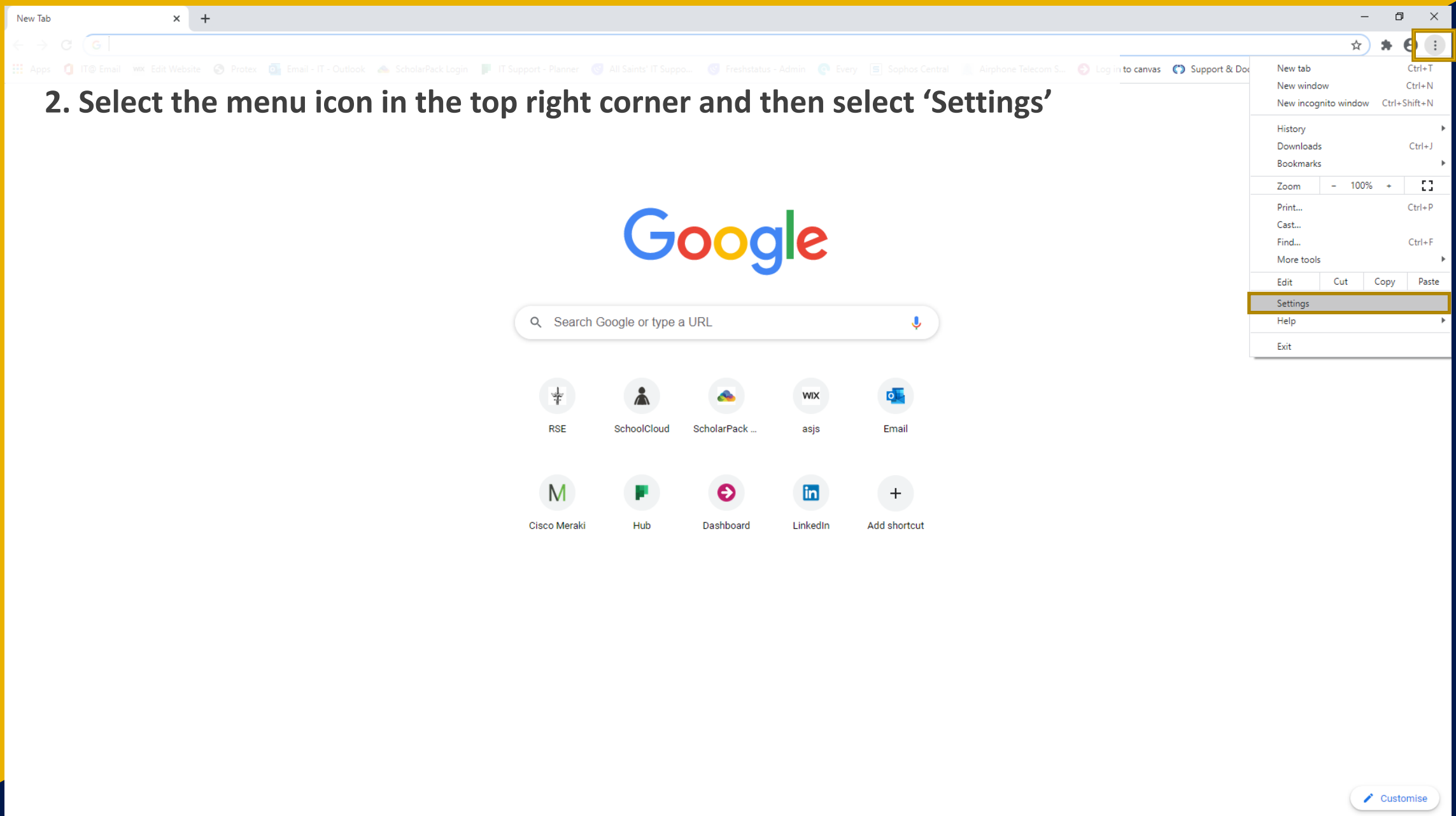


**Removing via web
browser**

1. Firstly go to the internet. For this example I will be using Google Chrome



2. Select the menu icon in the top right corner and then select 'Settings'

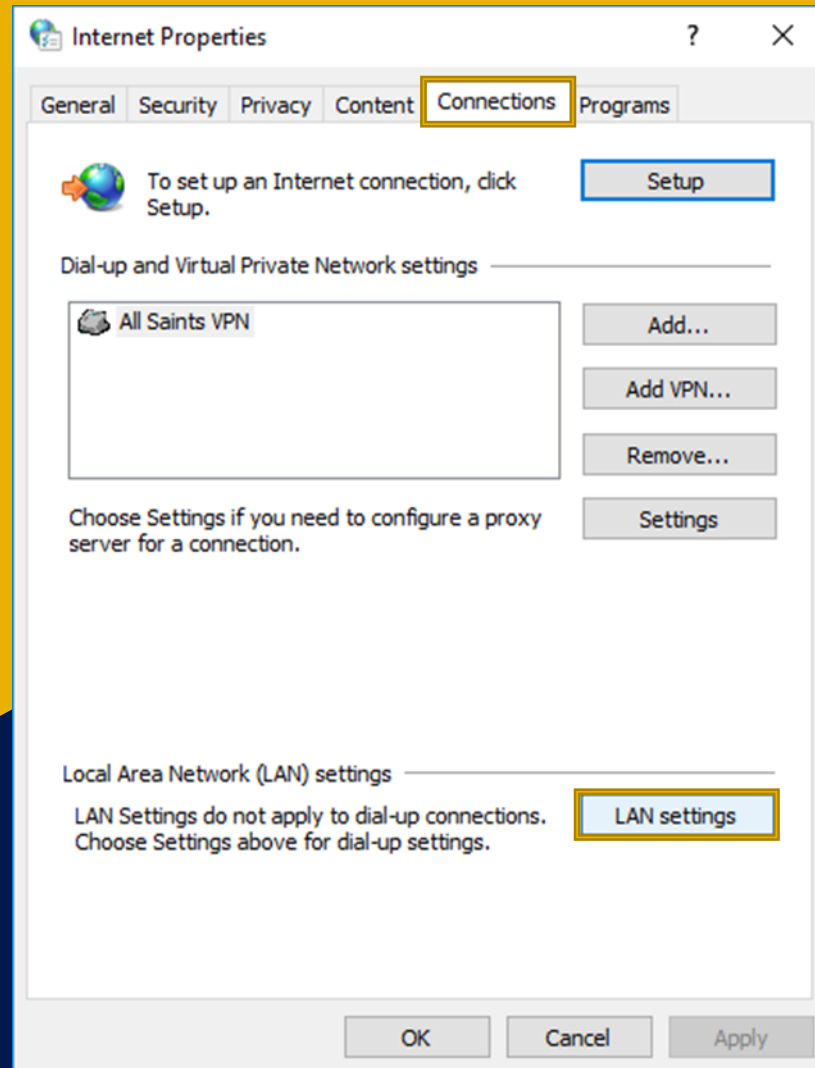

- Continue running background apps when Google Chrome is closed
- Use hardware acceleration when available
- Open your computer's **proxy** settings

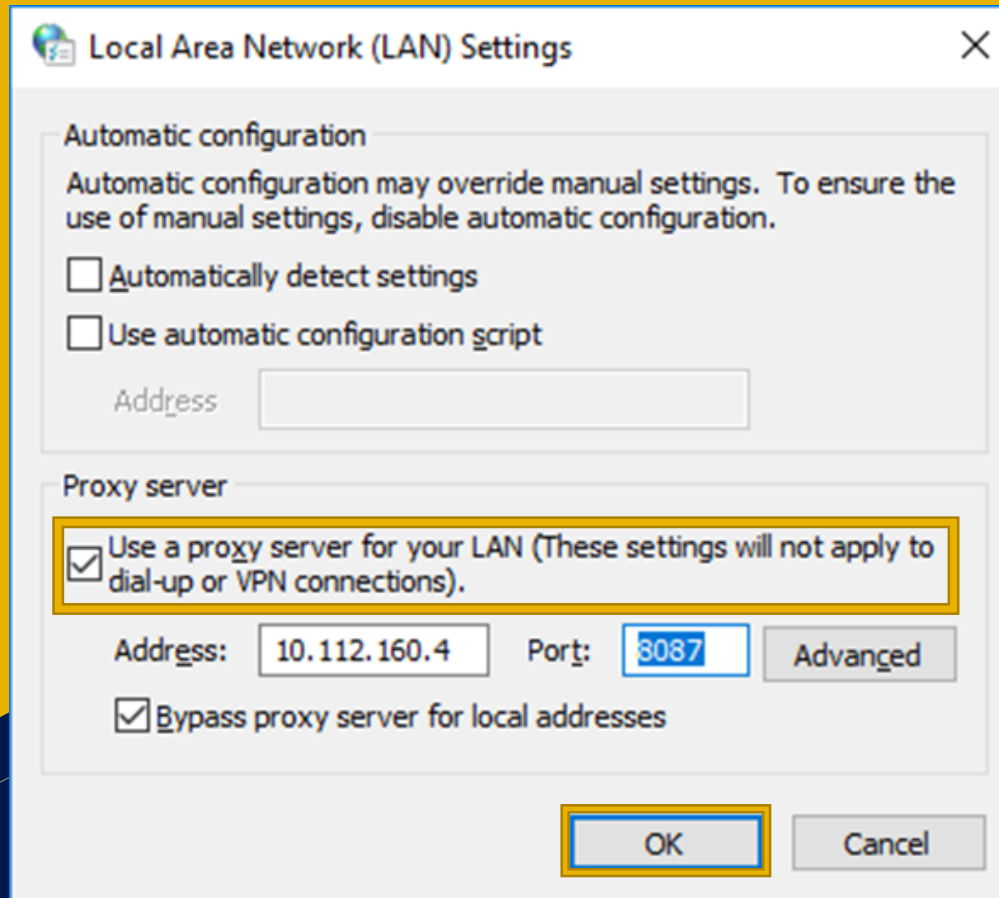
3. In the search bar, look for 'Proxy'

4. In the 'Internet Properties' window. Click on the 'Connections' tab along the top row.

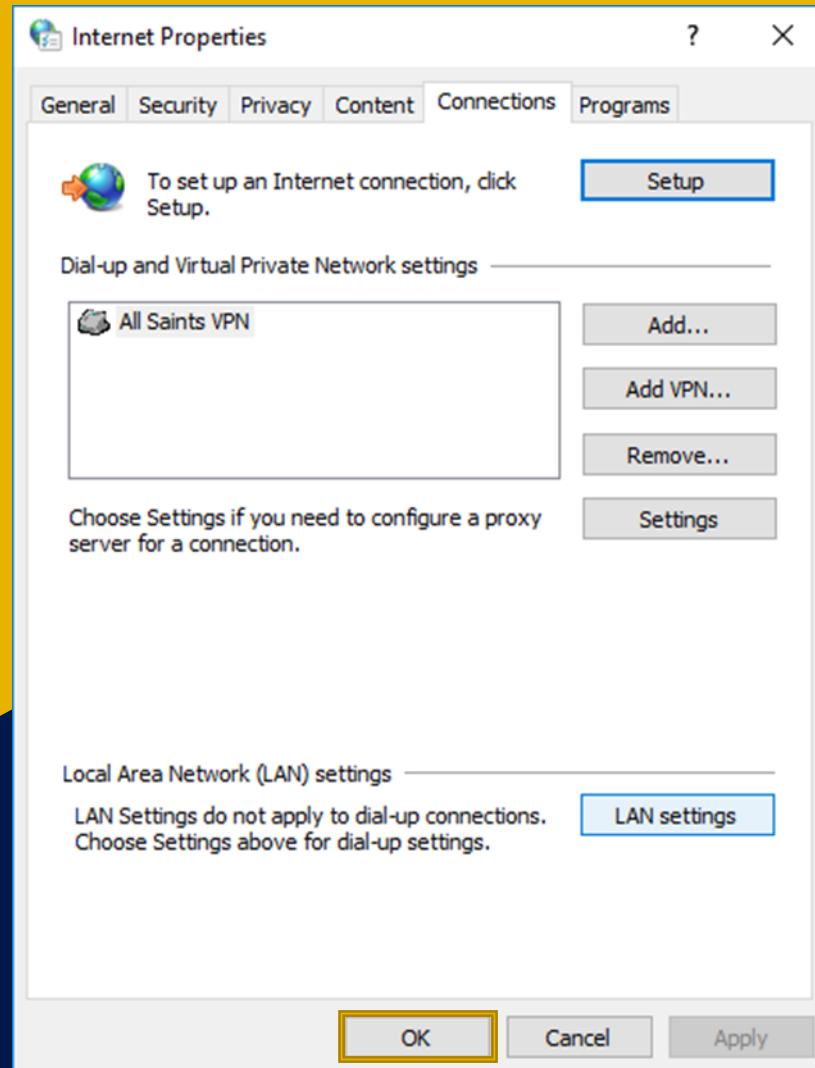
Once on the 'Connections' tab then select 'LAN settings'.



5. In the next window (as shown above), you need to untick the box that says “Use a proxy server for your LAN”. Once unticked then click ‘Ok’.



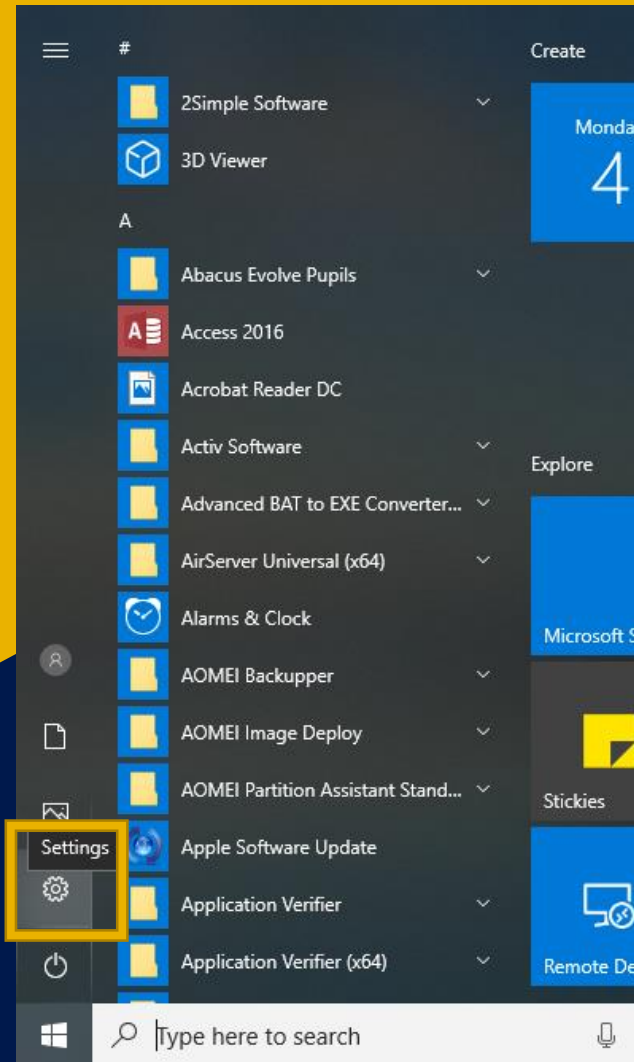
6. Once that window has closed, click 'Ok' on the Internet Properties page and then refresh your internet screen. You will then be connected to the internet.



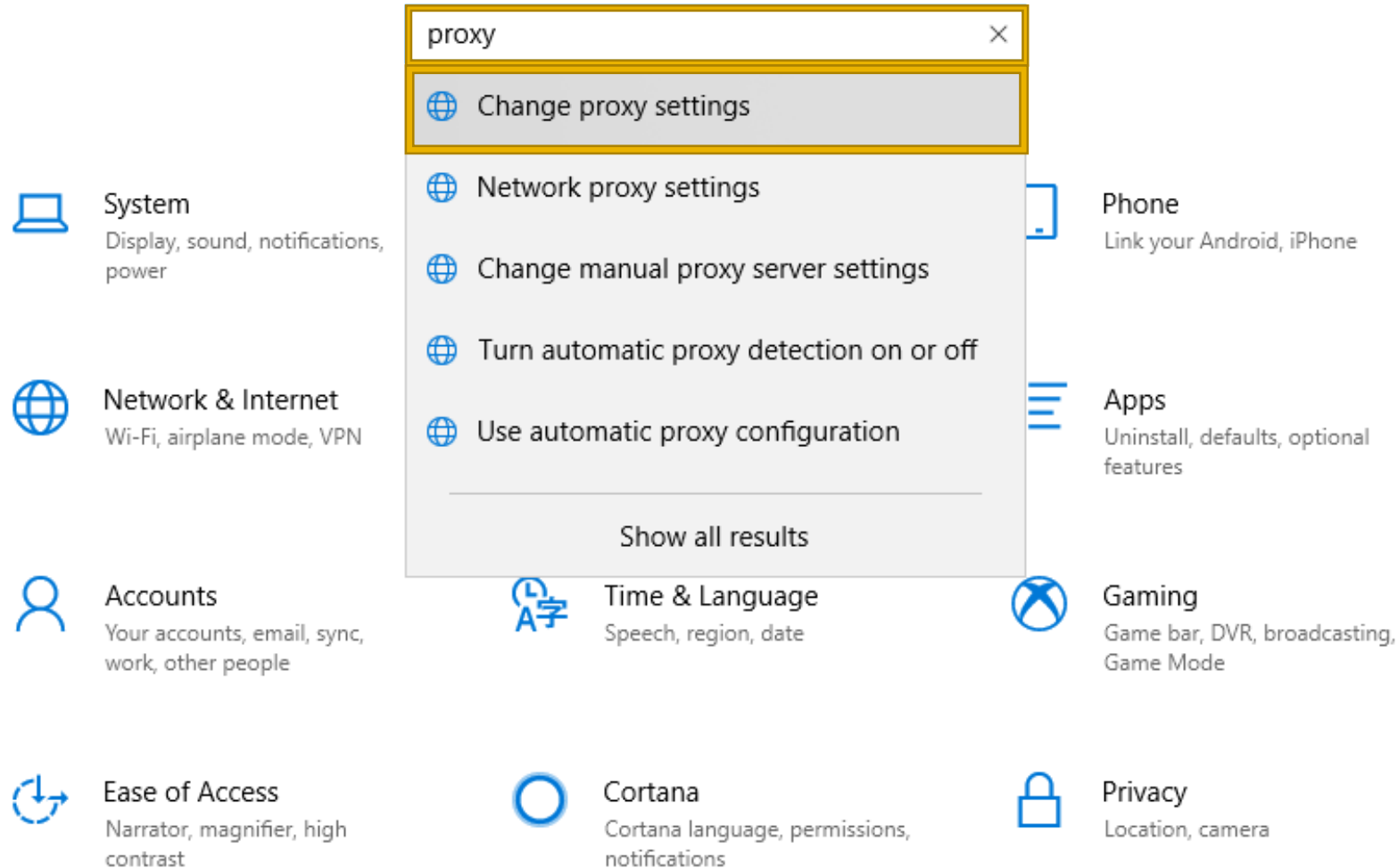


**Removing via PC
settings**

1. To turn off the proxy settings through the computer settings. Firstly go to the start menu by clicking the Windows logo in the bottom left hand corner of the screen. Then click on the 'Settings' icon located just above the power icon on the left hand side.



2. Once clicked the following window will then appear. Then in the search bar type 'Proxy' and click on 'Change proxy settings'.



3. Then in the proxy window scroll down and select the check icon under 'Use a proxy server'.

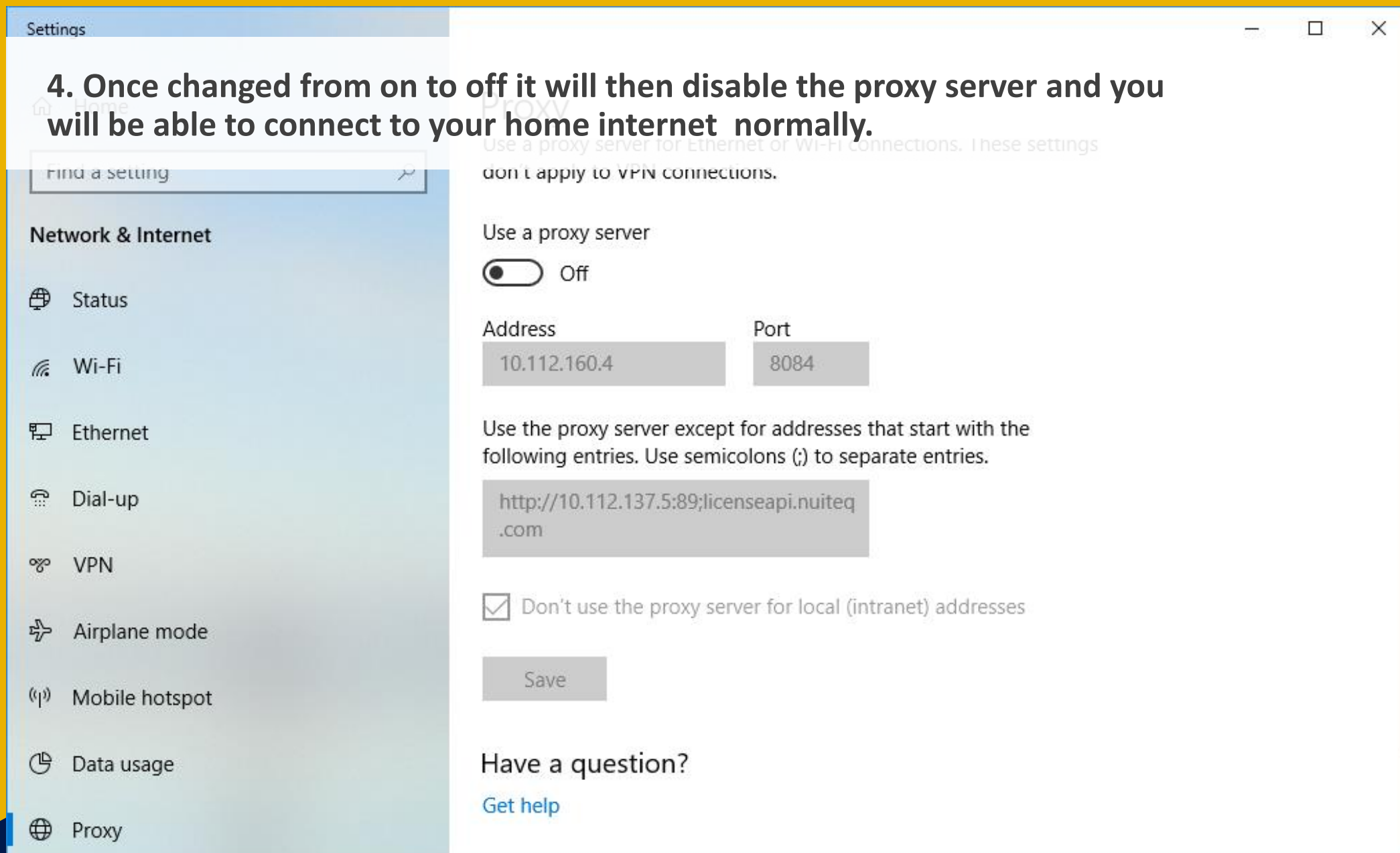
Don't use the proxy server for local (intranet) addresses
