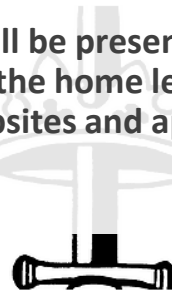
Home Learning

Home learning opportunities that enrich the learning, which takes place in school.

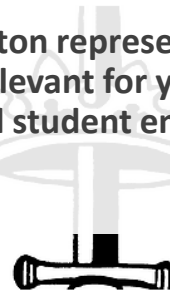

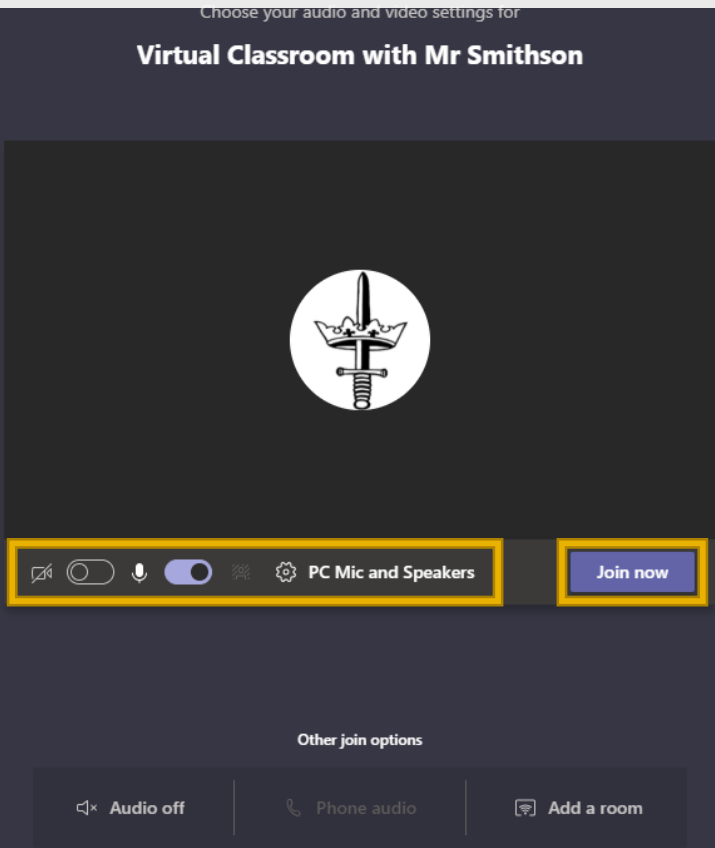

Once in the session join page you want to click on either the text that says 'Join Microsoft Teams Meeting' or click the 'Join' button in the top right hand corner of your screen.

Once you have clicked 'Join' you will be presented with the following screen. On here you will need to ensure that your camera and Microsoft are turned on by using the toggle buttons at the bottom. You will also need to ensure that your sound is turned on to hear everyone else in the meeting. When everything is set and ready, hit 'Join Now' to enter your virtual classroom.
